

# **IC259 - Action Required, All Countries to Rank Applications for 2009 World Laser 4.7 Youth Championship by 28th January 2009**

**23rd January 2009**

All Countries and the North American Region are required to rank their sailors for the 2009 World Laser 4.7 Youth Championship by 28th January 2009. You can quickly check if any sailors from your District have completed an application for entry by viewing the online Application List

(<http://events.laserinternational.org/en/application/list/100z40>). Please remember that, as this championship has a separate allocation for boys and girls, you must rank applicants from four lists:

Boys Laser 4.7 - I DO need an ILCA Charter Boat

Girls Laser 4.7 - I DO need an ILCA Charter Boat

Boys Laser 4.7 - I do NOT need an ILCA Charter Boat

Girls Laser 4.7 - I do NOT need an ILCA Charter Boat

Please note that a limited number of charter boats are available. Charter boats are only issued as part of the entry allocation, so sailors must select the correct list when making application to be considered for a charter boat.

**The deadline for ranking applications for entry is before 28th January 2009. ALL COUNTRIES PLEASE ACT NOW.**

To rank sailors, please log into the District ranking area on our website, scroll down to the middle of the page where the "World Laser 4.7 Youth Championship 2009" is listed and select the link at the very bottom of the brown box labelled "Process Applications". Further instructions are available from <http://events.laserinternational.org/en/application/explanation>. If you do not have your login details for the ranking pages, please contact the ILCA office.

For full instructions on how to rank sailors please refer to International Circular IC245, which was sent on 24th September 2008.

**Any Countries that have not ranked their sailors by the end of 28th January 2009 will lose their allocated places.** Also, any allocated places in excess of the number of ranked sailors for each championship will be lost for the Country. For example, if you have 5 allocated places and only 3 ranked sailors, the 2 spare places will be returned to ILCA for distribution to other Countries.

Please rank all of your sailors even if there is only one sailor or if you have more sailors than allocated places. For example, if you have 8 sailors and only 5 allocated places please rank all sailors from 1-8. Sailors 1-5 will be given the allocated places but if any of the places are not taken up by the sailor ILCA would offer the place to the next ranked sailor on your ranking list.

If you are unable to rank your sailors now, please declare a late ranking date and

reserve the number of places you require. You can do this on the District ranking pages by selecting 'Yes' in the drop down box under the heading 'Registering your Districts Places without the Sailor's Details'. Further information on how to set a late ranking date can be found in IC245.
